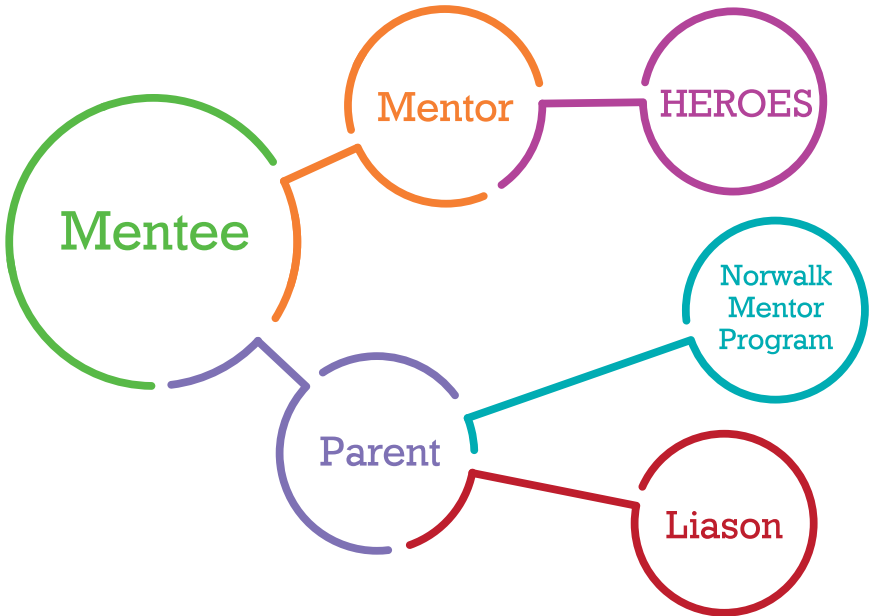
Helping Enrich Relationships Of Every Student

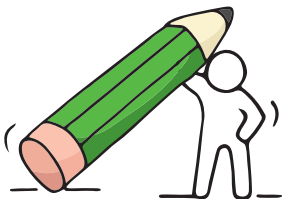
The national cost of a school-based mentoring program is approximately \$1,000 annually for each mentor/mentee match. At the Norwalk Mentor Program, we are able to keep our costs down, while providing the highest quality of care for the program. For \$750 per year, you can become one of our HEROES by helping sponsor one of these matches. Your annual donation will be used for a number of expenses, including general operating costs, events throughout the year for mentors and mentees to attend, and workshops that help mentors make the most of their time with their students. While your donation of \$750 is for one year, we hope that you will continue to support the program on an annual basis.
